Jeffery F. Miller, Ph.D., is the M. Phillip Davis Endowed Chair in Microbiology and Immunology, and Professor and Chairman of the Department of Microbiology, Immunology and Molecular Genetics at UCLA. His research focuses on molecular mechanisms of bacterial virulence. He is currently on the Executive Board of the Pacific Southwest Regional Center of Excellence in Biodefense and Emerging Infectious Diseases; he is co-Director of the DOD-funded UCLA Global Biolab for Infectious Disease Surveillance, co-Founder and Chair of the Scientific Advisory Board of AvidBiotics, Inc., and Chair of the General Meeting of the American Society for Microbiology (2007-2010). He has published and presented extensively. He is an Elected Fellow of the American Academy of Microbiology, an Editor of Microbiology and Molecular Biology Reviews, and a member of the editorial boards of Current Opinion in Microbiology and mBio. Dr. Miller has participated and chaired on multiple NIH study sections on bacterial pathogenesis and genome science.
