

David C. Dale, M.D. is Professor of Medicine at the University of Washington, where he is actively involved in teaching, research, and patient care. He previously served as Dean of the School of Medicine, University of Washington; President of the Society of General Internal Medicine; President of the Medical Honor Society-Alpha Omega Alpha; and President of the American College of Physicians. He is Editor-in-Chief Emeritus for the medical textbook *Scientific American Medicine/ACP Medicine* and has held several other editorial positions. He serves on the National Board of Sponsors for Physicians for Social Responsibility and is the founding Director of the Severe Chronic Neutropenia International Registry and Repository, an organization dedicated to understanding the genetic and molecular mechanisms for diseases causing neutropenia and finding better treatments for patients afflicted with these diseases. He is a graduate of Carson-Newman College and Harvard Medical School and trained in internal medicine, infectious diseases, and hematology at the Massachusetts General Hospital, National Institutes of Health, and the University of Washington.
