

Steven Teutsch, M.D., M.P.H. is Chief Science Officer of the Los Angeles County Health Department, and an Adjunct Professor at the Emory University School of Public Health and UNC School of Public Health. Until November 2008, he was the Executive Director of Outcomes Research at Merck & Company.
