

Barbara Burns McGrath, RN, PhD is a nurse and medical anthropologist on the faculty of the University of Washington, School of Nursing. She has adjunct appointments in the Departments of Anthropology and Epidemiology, and is Director of the Gender Disparities Core of the Center for Women's Health and Gender Research at the UW. Research interests include investigation of cultural variation in response to illness, examination of the role of science and technology in the health of populations, and the application of ethnography and community based participatory research methods. She is also on the faculty of the Institute for Public Health Genetics and teaches a graduate course on the intersection of science and society focusing on the social/cultural implications of genetic science and technologies.
